

Privacy facts statement about TELUS



Scope

This statement applies to the TELUS family of companies, including those carrying on business as TELUS Communications, TELUS Mobility, TELUS Internet Services and TELUS Québec.

Personal information

Personal information is information about **an identifiable individual**. This includes information about your product and service subscriptions and usage. TELUS collects information about you during the application process (to confirm your identity and credit history), when communicating or transacting business with you, and when providing service to you. We may also collect information about you from third parties that have the right to disclose such information to us.

Collection, use and sharing

We collect and use information about you:

- To establish and maintain a responsible commercial relationship with you and to provide ongoing service
- To manage your account and understand your needs and preferences, allowing us to offer you other products and services that we think may be of interest to you
- To develop, enhance, market and provide products and services, and to manage and develop our business and operations

There are a variety of circumstances where we may need to disclose or share some personal information about you. For example, we may disclose or share:

- To a person who, in the reasonable judgment of TELUS, is acting as your agent
- To another communications company or a company involved in supplying you with communications or communications directory-related services
- To a person employed by TELUS to perform functions on its behalf
- To an agent used by TELUS to evaluate a customer's credit worthiness or to collect the customer's account
- To public authorities or their agents in cases of emergency (e.g., if a customer makes a 911 call)

Any disclosure outside of TELUS is made on a confidential basis with the information to be used only for the purposes for which it was disclosed.

Subject to applicable CRTC regulations:

- Information may also be shared among TELUS business units to help us serve you better
- Information may be shared with credit reporting agencies

From time to time, TELUS may sell parts of its business, sell or securitize assets, or merge or amalgamate parts of its business with other entities. TELUS may disclose information about customers and accounts in the normal course of such transactions as part of due diligence and/or on completion of the transaction.

We may also collect, use and disclose information to meet legal and regulatory requirements.
